3-on-3 Hockey Double Elimination Tournament

Sunday, February 12th ~ 10:00am-4:00pm

Teams: One Division: General (14+)

Consist of 3 people (one being the goalie) w/ up to 1 substitutes

A minimum of 3 players is required to start a game

There will be one dedicated Team Captain on each team

You must have a team name—Be Appropriate!

Only **16 teams** will be allowed to compete in this tournament—First come, first serve!

Due to possible time limitations, **Single Elimination** may be initiated at any point mid-tournament

Advance Registration is at Storm Lake United and BVU Student Services, and will be allowed until February 10th.

Team Captains must fill out a registration form for their team with the appropriate signatures from team mates.

Registrations WILL NOT be confirmed until COMPLETED form is received.

Signatures may be completed on day of competition prior to event.

Late registrations will be accepted on the day of the event at the registration table until 9:30am.

The Rink Area of Play will consist of a single ice rink of approximate size, 120ft x 80ft.

- * Play will be announced for each court via the TEAM NAME—players are responsible for paying attention to whom is coming up next.
- * Teams are allowed 10 minutes from time of announcement to have players ready or they will forfeit.

Rules:

Basic Rules are similar to that of hockey. The following are some important exceptions and safety rules:

Only Ice Skates are Approved Footwear!

There are no goalies—players skates are not allowed inside goal crease. The result of penalty will be no goal and turnover of possession (if offensive violation) and turnover of puck (if defensive violation). In the case of defensive violation, the opposing team has the option to decline the penalty (allow goal).

Pucks, sticks, and skates are available for use. You are only allowed to use the puck provided.

All other clothing or gear is the responsibility of the participant.

Players will not be allowed to wear any equipment that is deemed unsafe for other players.

There will be 2 officials per game.

There are two 10 minute halves with a two minute half-time.

Play will be initiated by faceoff after each point and or half; official may decide to allot the team scored against possession of puck in their half of the rink after a point has been scored against them.

Out of play (or out-of-bounds) puck will result in possession given to opposing team.

No Checking—accidental checking will result in turnover of possession; **intentional checking will result in an ejection from the game and automatic team loss.**

No high-sticking—the sticks may not be swung above your waste; penalty will be similar to checking.

Ties will result in a shoot-out of three players from center line.

Standard hockey rules except: **there are no off-sides except during face-off.**
