

# Broomball Double Elimination Tournament

Saturday, February 11<sup>th</sup> ~ 10:00am-5:00pm

**Teams:** Two Divisions: Youth (14-18 yrs) and Adult (18+)

Consist of 8 people (one being the goalie) w/ up to 2 substitutes

A minimum of 5 players is required to start a game

**COED**—must be two members of the opposite sex in play at all times

There will be one dedicated Team Captain on each team

You must have a team name—Be Appropriate!

Only **16 teams** will be allowed to compete in each division of this tournament—First come, first serve!

Due to possible time limitations, **Single Elimination** may be initiated at any point mid-tournament

**Cash Prize (16 team entry\*):** 1<sup>st</sup> = 50%    2<sup>nd</sup> = 33%    3<sup>rd</sup> = 17%

\*Dependent upon number of teams entered.

**Advance Registration** is at Storm Lake United and BVU Student Services, and will be allowed until February 10<sup>th</sup>.

Team Captains must fill out a registration form for their team and attach signed liability waivers from all their teammates.

Registrations WILL NOT be complete until contact information and \$30 registration fee per team are received.

Signatures may be completed on day of competition prior to event.

Late registrations will be accepted on the day of the event at the registration tent until 9:30am.

**Entry Fee--\$30/team;** the entry fee must be turned into Storm Lake United or the BVU Student Services Office to reserve a spot in the tournament, & team captains are responsible for collecting the money from team members. Make checks payable to Storm Lake United.

**The Broomball Court** will consist of a single ice rink divided into two courts of a size 100ft x 60ft.

## Schedule:

\* Play will be announced for each court via the TEAM NAME—players are responsible for paying attention to whom is coming up next.

\* Teams are allowed 10 minutes from time of announcement to have players ready or they will forfeit.

## Rules:

Basic Rules are similar to that of hockey. The following are some important exceptions and safety rules:

**Sneakers or snow boots are approved footwear.** No skates, cleats, or cramp-ons will be allowed!

**Helmets** for goalies will be provided for and **MUST BE WORN** during play!

Brooms and balls will be provided for. You are only allowed to use the provided gear to insure a fair competition.

All other clothing or gear is the responsibility of the participant.

Players will not be allowed to wear any equipment that is deemed unsafe for other players.

There will be 2 officials per game.

There are two 10 minute halves with a one minute half-time.

**No Checking**—it will result in an ejection from the game + 5 min penalty.

**No high-sticking**—the broom may not be swung above your waste; i.e. the broom bristles are not allowed to come above your waste.

The goalie is the only player allowed to grab and/or freeze the ball—only within the goal crease (4ft radius semi-circle around the goal).

Ties will result in a shoot-out.

There is no offside's except during face-off.

A goalie may not throw a ball beyond half court—he/she must pass to a player on their half.
