

Snow Sculpture Competition (1 Category)

Sunday, February 12th ~ 1:00-4:00pm

Two Divisions: General and Family

Time: 2 Hours are allowed for construction; Judging will occur following completion of 2 hour construction period.

Teams: You are allowed to work alone or in teams up to 5. No exceptions.

****Obscene snow sculptures will **disqualify** the individual/s from all Winter Festival events!**

Schedule:

12:30-2 pm	Sign-in at event table
2-4 pm	Construction Period
4-4:30 pm	Judging

Preregistration: Space is limited, so preregistration is suggested by submitting a registration form to Storm Lake United or BVU Student Services by February 10th. Late registrations will be allowed at the event area in Scout Park until 2:00pm on the 12th. This event is free to the public.

Regulations: The competition will be held in the area in and around Scout Park—Lighthouse. Tools for shaping snow are allowed, but not necessary. (No power tools allowed). Each participant is responsible for their own “tools” for shaping and transporting snow. Do not include participants name on or around snow sculpture. Participants will be given a colored number in which to identify their snow sculpture. Food coloring is the only coloring allowed.

Judging: Participants will be judged on three categories: creativity, esthetic appeal, quality of workmanship. There are 10 possible points in each category; final scores will be an average of the three judge’s scores; 1st, 2nd, & 3rd places will be awarded for each division. Participants are asked to leave snow sculptures at 4 pm.

Advance Registration is at Storm Lake United and BVU Student Services. Advanced registration is allowed up to the February 10th. All late registrants can register at the event itself on February 12th; however some events are limited on number of participants! Awards for all events will be held/given after the event.
